Take notice that:

1. Ideal Life, Inc. (the “**Company**”) filed an assignment on March 2, 2023, and the undersigned, Richter Inc., was appointed as trustee (“**Trustee**”) of the Company’s bankrupt estate by the Official Receiver, subject to affirmation by the creditors of the Trustee’s appointment or substitution of another trustee by the creditors.
2. The first meeting of creditors of the bankrupt will be held on March 22, 2023 at 1:00 PM via videoconference (the “**Meeting**”). As the Meeting is to be held remotely, creditors who wish to attend the Meeting are required to complete the attached registration form and return it by email to the Trustee at the following email address: [claims@richter.ca](mailto:claims@richter.ca), no later than **5:00 PM (Toronto time) on March 21, 2023**.
3. Enclosed with this notice is a (i) condensed statement of assets and liabilities, including a list of creditors showing the amounts of their claims (as per the Company’s records), (ii) form of proof of claim and proxy, and (iii) registration form to participate in the Meeting.
4. To be entitled to vote at the Meeting, a creditor must file with the Trustee, before the Meeting, a proof of claim and, where necessary, a proxy. Proofs of claim should be forwarded to Richter Inc., Bay Wellington Tower, 181 Bay Street, Suite 3510, Toronto, Ontario, M5J 2T3 to the attention of Adam Zeldin or sent by facsimile to (514) 934-8603 or by email to [claims@richter.ca](mailto:claims@richter.ca).
5. Creditors must prove their claims against the estate of the bankrupt to share in any distribution of the proceeds realized, if any, from the estate.


