MOTION TO OBTAIN AN EXTENSION OF THE DELAY TO FILE A PROPOSAL
(Article 50.4(9) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, L.R.C. 1985, c. B-3)

**TO ONE OF THE HONORABLE JUDGES OR THE REGISTRAR OF THE SUPERIOR
COURT, SITTING IN COMMERCIAL DIVISION, IN AND FOR THE DISTRICT OF
MONTRÉAL, THE DEBTOR/PETITIONER SUBMITS THE FOLLOWING:**

1. On October 10, 2014, the Debtor/Petitioner filed a notice of intention to make a proposal (the "NOI") pursuant to the provisions of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (the "BIA"), the whole as appears from the Court record;
2. The Debtor/Petitioner specializes in the distribution of horticultural products in Québec and Eastern Ontario related to, *inter alia*, the irrigation and drainage of various types of properties, including sports fields (i.e. golf courses);
3. Richter Advisory Group Inc. (Mr. Philip Manel, CPA, CA, CIRP) was named Trustee to the NOI, the whole as appears from the Court record as well as the certificate of filing of the NOI, communicated herewith as Exhibit P-1;

4. In the ten (10) days following the filing of the NOI, the Debtor/Petitioner filed with the Superintendent of Bankruptcy the necessary documents pursuant to Article 50.4(2) of the BIA;
5. The Debtor/Petitioner has had to avail itself of the relief of a proposal due to various economic factors, being general economic downturn and more specifically, the current unfavourable economic conditions facing the golf industry, being an important industry in which the Debtor/Petitioner operates, which has led to insufficient funding of its operations; as well, the Debtor/Petitioner has lost the support of a major supplier of irrigation products, Rain Bird Corporation, which has led to the cancellation of its most important distribution agreement;
6. Since the filing of the NOI, the directors of the Debtor/Petitioner along with the Trustee, as the case may be, have proceeded to analyse the financials of the Debtor/Petitioner, to make an inventory of its assets, to make arrangements with its various secured creditors, and to negotiate with prospective purchasers and/or investors an asset or share purchase agreement (the "Transaction") for substantially all of its inventory and assets;
7. More specifically, since the filing of its NOI, the Debtor/Petitioner has met with several prospective purchasers and/or investors to negotiate the Transaction and it is confident that an extension of forty-five (45) days will likely permit it to conclude the Transaction, which will maximize the value of the Debtor/Petitioner's assets for the overall benefit of its creditors;
8. The Debtor/Petitioner is currently in serious negotiations with a specific prospective purchaser, that shall remain anonymous for the time being, and is confident that if an extension of forty-five (45) days to make a proposal is granted, the Debtor/Petitioner will be able to conclude the Transaction, the proceeds of which will fund the proposal;
9. As such, the Debtor/Petitioner requires an additional forty-five (45) day delay in order to make a proposal, the whole as permitted by Article 50.4(9) of the BIA and this until December 22, 2014;
10. Consequently, it is respectfully submitted that if the present motion is granted, the additional delay of forty-five (45) days will permit the Debtor/Petitioner to conclude a successful transaction and thereby enable it to make a viable proposal to its creditors;
11. In support of the present motion, the Debtor/Petitioner files herewith the Trustee's report on the state of the insolvent person's business and financial affairs as prescribed by Article 50.4(7)(b) of the BIA, which report includes the projected cash flow of the insolvent person covering the period of the extension sought herein as well as the other documents filed with the official receiver, the whole in order to support the present motion, communicated herewith, *en l'iasse*, as Exhibit P-2;
12. In addition, the Debtor/Petitioner respectfully submits that it has and continues to act in good faith and with due diligence;
13. No creditor will be materially prejudiced if the present motion is granted;

14. Quite the opposite, the creditors, as a whole, will be materially prejudiced if the present motion is refused;
15. In fact, no creditor has manifested its intention to contest the present motion;
16. Moreover, the Debtor/Petitioner's secured creditor, Accord Financial, does not object to the requested extension and supports the Debtor/Petitioner in its reorganization efforts
17. The Debtor/Petitioner is currently in operation while negotiating the Transaction and is current with its source deductions, its various tax liabilities and the salaries of its employees as these become due;
18. Based on the above, the initial delay of thirty (30) days provided for in the BIA to make a proposal is not sufficient for the Debtor/Petitioner;
19. Accordingly, and for these reasons, the Debtor/Petitioner requests that this Honourable Court grant it an extension of forty-five (45) days to make a proposal to its creditors, until December 22, 2014;
20. The Trustee is also of the opinion that an extension of the delay to make a proposal should be granted by this Court in order to permit the Debtor/Petitioner with the necessary time to conclude the Transaction and to make a viable proposal to its creditors;
21. The present motion is well founded in fact and in law;

FOR THESE REASONS, MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT:

GRANT the present motion;

DECLARE that the delays of service and presentation of the motion are sufficient;

REDUCE AND WAIVE all delays and requirements to serve and present the present motion;

EXTEND the delay to make a proposal to the official receiver until **December 22, 2014**;

THE WHOLE without costs, save in the case of contestation.

TRUSTEE'S REPORT ON THE STATE OF THE INSOLVENT PERSON'S
BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL AFFAIRS
(Pursuant to Sections 50.4(7)(b)(ii) and 50.4(9) of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act)

I, Philip Manei, CPA, CA, CIRP, of Richter Advisory Group Inc. ("Richter"), Trustee, with respect to the Notice of Intention to Make a Proposal ("Notice of Intention") filed by 161617 Canada Inc. (the "Company" or "Debtor"), an insolvent person, do hereby report to the Court the following:

1. On October 10, 2014, the Debtor filed a Notice of Intention in accordance with the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (the "Act"), a copy of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit "A".
2. On October 16, 2014, documents were sent by regular mail to all creditors of the Debtor, as identified by it, which included a copy of the Debtor's Notice of Intention, as annexed hereto as Exhibit "B".
3. On October 16, 2014, the Debtor filed with the Official Receiver a Statement of Projected Cash Flow ("Projections") together with his report pursuant to Section 50.4(2)(c) of the Act, covering the period from October 11, 2014 to November 7, 2014, which included the major Assumptions used in the preparation of the aforementioned Projections. Concurrently therewith, the Trustee filed its Report on the reasonableness of the Projections in accordance with Section 50.4(2)(b) of the Act, all of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit "C".
4. In order to monitor the affairs and finances of the Debtor, the Trustee has been provided with access to the books, records and other important documents of the Debtor.

5. The Debtor has been paying its suppliers and employees, on a timely basis, for goods and services provided subsequent to the date of the filing of the Notice of intention, according to the current business terms. The Trustee has compared the actual results to those projected since the filing of the Notice of intention. The actual results to date have been favorable.
6. The Company, in operation since 1988, is engaged in the distribution of horticultural products, in Quebec and eastern Ontario.
7. At the time of the filing, the Company had over 14 employees working at its head office and warehouse.
8. In the past two years, the Company has experienced a significant decline of its sales and reported significant losses. Management attributes this decline in sales to the following:
 - Current unfavorable economic conditions in the golf Industry;
 - Insufficient funding of its operations; and
 - General economic downturn.
9. Pursuant to the assessment of its financial situation, Management began implementing, in early 2014, certain corrective measures, with the intent of ensuring its long-term profitability. However, in July 2014, the Company lost the support of its main supplier of irrigation equipment. This event further aggravated the decline of its sales, necessitating a formal restructuring through a Notice of intention.
10. Pursuant to the filing of the Notice of Intention, the Company has been developing and implementing its restructuring plan. The key elements of this plan include:
 - The liquidation of its slow-moving and excess inventory;
 - The reduction of operating and overhead expenses;
 - The search for potential investors and/or acquirers who could participate in the restructuring. The Debtor is currently in talks with one potential acquirer who could participate in the financing of a Proposal; and
 - The determination of the terms of a viable proposal to its unsecured creditors.
11. The Debtor is filing a Motion to Extend the Delay for the Filing of a Proposal, in order to allow it to complete its dealings with regards to the above-mentioned key elements and to enable the formulation of a viable proposal to its creditors.
12. The Debtor's secured creditor, Accord Financial, does not object to the requested extension and supports the Debtor in its reorganization efforts.
13. Annexed hereto as Exhibit "D" is the Statement of Projected Cash Flow covering the period from November 3 to December 22, 2014, the Trustee's Report on the reasonableness of the Projections in accordance with Section 50.4(2)(b) of the Act and the Debtor's Report pursuant to Section 50.4(2)(c) of the Act.

14. if the extension is granted, the Trustee is not aware of any facts indicating that any creditor would suffer a prejudice.
15. Given the foregoing, the Trustee hereby recommends the granting of the extension by the Court to December 22, 2014.
