2. The pre-trial conference in the above-captioned adversary proceeding shall take place on **August 18, 2015** at **10:30 a.m. E.S.T.** following the 10:30 a.m. hearing on CP's Motion to Dismiss.
3. The Objection Deadline with respect to the Motion to Dismiss is extended to **July 21, 2015**.
4. This Order will become final in fourteen (14) days unless a party in interest sooner objects, in which case the matter shall be set for hearing and considered by the Court as if this Order had not been entered.
