**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED HEARING, SHORTENED
OBJECTION PERIOD AND LIMITED NOTICE WITH RESPECT TO
CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE'S FIRST OMNIBUS MOTION FOR AN
ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) AND 365 FOR
AUTHORIZATION TO REJECT EXECUTORY
CONTRACTS AND UNEXPIRED LEASES AS
OF THE CLOSING OF THE SALE OF
THE DEBTOR'S ASSETS**

This matter having come before the Court on the Motion for Expedited Hearing, Shortened Objection Period and Limited Notice with Respect to Chapter 11 Trustee's First Omnibus Motion for an Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) and 365 for Authorization to Reject Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases as of the Closing of the Sale of the Debtor's Assets (the "Motion to Expedite") filed by Robert J. Keach, the chapter 11 trustee in the above-captioned case, and upon consideration of all responses to the Motion to Expedite (if any), it is hereby **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** as follows:

1. The Motion to Expedite is granted.
2. Notice and service of the Motion to Expedite and the Chapter 11 Trustee's First Omnibus Motion for an Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) and 365 for Authorization to Reject Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases as of the Closing of the Sale of the Debtor's Assets (the "Motion") was sufficient in light of the nature of the relief requested.
3. An expedited hearing on the Motion is set for **May 27, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. (ET)**

and the deadline to object to the same is **May 27, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. (ET)**.
