You may attend the hearing with respect to the Admin Claims Objections, which is scheduled for <u>May 23, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. ET</u> (the "<u>Hearing</u>") before the Honorable Judge Peter G. Cary, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maine (the "<u>Court</u>"), 537 Congress Street, 2nd Floor, Portland, Maine.

<u>Your rights may be affected</u>. You should read the Admin Claims Objections carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one. If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one. If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the Court may decide that you do not oppose the relief sought, and may enter an order sustaining the Admin Claims Objections without further notice or hearing.

Nothing in this Notice or the Admin Claims Objections constitutes a waiver of any claims, counterclaims, rights of offset or recoupment, preference actions, fraudulent-transfer actions, or any other bankruptcy claims against you.
