**FIFTH EXTENSION ORDER**

---

**CONSIDERING** the Monitor's "*Fifth Petition for the Extension of the Stay Order*" (the "Petition") and its supporting exhibits;

**CONSIDERING** the representations made by counsel; and

**GIVEN** the provisions of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*;

**WHEREFORE, THE COURT:**

**GRANTS** the *Fifth Petition for the Extension of the Stay Order* (the "**Petition**");

**EXTENDS** the Stay Period and the Stay Termination Date (as defined in the Order rendered on November 18, 2008 by the Honourable William Fraiberg, J.S.C., (the "**Initial Order**")), up to and including June 30, 2009;

**RENEWS**, in full, subject to any necessary adaptations, the Initial Order until June 30, 2009;

**APPROVES** the Monitor's activities, as described in the Monitor's Sixth Report and the Supplement to the Sixth Report (Exhibit P-1 *en liasse* to the Petition);

**ORDERS** that upon written notice of one business day provided by the Monitor, 4488385 Canada Inc. (the "**Purchaser**") give the Monitor full access to the books, records and other documents of Komunik Corporation, Komunik Datamark Inc. and Komunik Intramedia Inc. (collectively, the "**Company**") relied upon by the Purchaser to justify its recalculation of the Purchased Working Capital specified in its Objection Notice of April 23, 2009, as well as to any other books, records and documents in its possession the Monitor believes necessary or useful to verify such recalculation during normal business hours and that the Purchaser then make knowledgeable representative(s) available to respond to such questions as the Monitor may have relating to the recalculation;

**ORDERS** that the Purchaser provide the Monitor with copies in hard copy or electronic format of such of the foregoing books, records and documents as the Monitor may request, within two business days of such request, or permit the Monitor to make such copies on site, in either case at the latter's cost;

**ORDERS** the provisional execution of the order to be rendered herein notwithstanding any appeal;

**THE WHOLE**, without costs.
