**ORDER GRANTING FOURTH CONSENT MOTION TO EXTEND THE OBJECTION
DEADLINE AND CONTINUE THE HEARING ON THE TRUSTEE'S
MOTIONS FOR RULE 2004 EXAMINATIONS**


Upon consideration of the *Fourth Consent Motion to Extend Objection Deadline and Continue the Hearing on the Trustee's Motions for Rule 2004 Examinations* (the "Fourth Consent Motion") filed by Robert J. Keach, as trustee (the "Trustee") of Montreal Maine & Atlantic Railway, Ltd. (the "Debtor"), and the Trustee and the Requesting Parties consenting to the relief sought in the Fourth Consent Motion, and without hearing pursuant to D. Me. LBR 9013-1(d)(1) and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(b)(1), it is hereby **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** as follows:¹

1. The Fourth Consent Motion is granted.
2. The Hearing shall take place on **February 10, 2015** at **10:00 a.m. E.S.T.**
3. The Objection Deadline is extended, as it relates only to the Requesting Parties, up to and including **February 3, 2015**.

¹ Unless otherwise indicated, all capitalized terms used but not defined herein have the same meaning as ascribed to such terms in the Fourth Consent Motion.

4. This Order shall become final in fourteen (14) days unless a party in interest sooner objects, in which case the matter shall be set for hearing and considered by the court as if this Order had not been entered.
