If you wish to review a copy of the Motion for Expedited Hearing or the First Day Expedited Motion, you may request a copy from counsel for the Debtor or review the docket in the above-captioned case. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one).
