CONSENT APPLICATION TO ENLARGE TIME FOR UNITED STATES TRUSTEE TO FILE RESPONSE SECOND INTERIM APPLICATION OF TRUSTEE, ROBERT J. KEACH, FOR ALLOWANCE AND PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR THE PERIOD AUGUST 21, 2013 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2014

- 4. Consistent with the practice in this case, the United States Trustee and the Trustee have scheduled a time to discuss concerns and comments the United States Trustee has with respect to the Second Interim Compensation Application.
- 5. Although the United States Trustee is hopeful his concerns will be adequately addressed by the Trustee, he seeks an extension of the deadline to formally respond to the Second Interim Compensation Application, should the need arise.
- 6. The Trustee consents to the extension of the deadline to respond to the Second Interim Compensation Application, from November 10, 2014 to, and including, November 17, 2014.
- 7. The United States Trustee has not sought any other enlargements of time with respect to the Second Interim Compensation Application.
- 8. As previously stated, the Trustee consents to the enlargement. No other parties-in-interest have been consulted.
