

On April 9, 2013, the Debtor filed an Amended Proposal to its creditors, pursuant to the imput of the Ad Hoc Creditors' Committee and negotiations with the representatives of the Company.

On April 19, 2013, a re-amended Proposal was made which was accepted by the unsecured creditors on April 19, 2013.

On June 26, 2013, the Court approved ratification.
