TRUSTEE'S REPORT ON THE STATE OF THE INSOLVENT PERSON'S BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL AFFAIRS

(Pursuant to 50.4(7)(b)(ii) and 50.4(9) of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act)

- I, Stéphane De Broux, CPA, CA, CIRP, of Richter Advisory Group Inc. ("Richter"), Trustee, with respect to the Notice of Intention to Make a Proposal ("Notice of Intention") filed by Romatec Inc. (the "Company" or "Debtor"), an insolvent person, do hereby report to the Court the following:
- 1. On August 16, 2013, the Debtor filed a Notice of Intention in accordance with the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (the "Act"), a copy of which is annexed hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.
- 2. On August 21, 2013, the Debtor filed with the Official Receiver a Statement of Projected Cash Flow ("Projections") together with his report pursuant to Section 50.4(2)(c) of the Act, covering the period from August 12 to September 20, 2013, which included the major Assumptions used in the preparation of the aforenoted Projections. Concurrently therewith, the Trustee filed its Report on the reasonableness of the Projections in accordance with Section 50.4(2)(b) of the Act, all of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit "B".
- 3. On August 23, 2013, documents were sent by regular mail to all creditors of the Debtor, as identified by it, which included a copy of the Debtor's Notice of Intention, as annexed hereto as **Exhibit "C"**.

- 4. In order to monitor the affairs and finances of the Debtor, the Trustee has been provided with access to the books, records and other important documents of the Company.
- 5. The Trustee has compared the actual results to those projected since the filing of the Notice of Intention (August 12, 2013 to September 6, 2013 (the "Period")), of which the cumulative summary is annexed hereto as **"Exhibit D"**. The Company has been paying its suppliers and employees, on a timely basis, for goods and services provided subsequent to the date of the filing of the Notice of Intention, according with the current business terms. The actual results to date have been favorable and can be summarized as follows:
 - Cash receipts for the Period amounted to approximately \$893K, a \$33K favorable variance as compared to the Projections (\$860K);
 - Operating disbursements for the Period were \$673K, representing a \$113K positive variance as compared to the projected disbursements of \$786K;
 - The net cash flow for the period was positive \$183K as compared to the projected negative net cash flow of \$1K, resulting in a \$184K positive variance over the Projections.
- The Company is engaged in the distribution of industrial valves, pumps, and instrumentation products and solutions for the manufacturing and process industry for over 50 years, including, sectors such as Oil and Gas, Agriculture, Mining, Industrial and Water & Wastewater industries.
- 7. In the past two years, the Company has experienced a sharp and long term decline of its sales and reported significant losses, particularly heightened over the last year. Management attributes this decline in sales volume to the following:
 - Current unfavorable economic conditions in the engineering industry for liquid and gas processing;
 - General economic downturn;
 - Highly competitive market; and
 - Loss of major customers.
- 8. As a result of the above negative factors, in the beginning of 2013, the Company endeavored to perform an internal restructuring to eliminate costs and lower overhead with the intent of ensuring its long-term profitability. However, the decrease in the level of business continued to exceed the Company's expectations and the informal/internal restructuring was not successful, necessitating a formal restructuring through a Notice of Intention.
- 9. Pursuant to the filing of the Notice of Intention, the Company has been developing and implementing its restructuring plan. Moreover, the Debtor has been dealing with key elements of its affairs in the following manner:
 - Sending notices to disclaim/resiliate two commercial leases as well as several equipment rental contracts;

- Reduce operating expenses and overhead;
- Assess its business plan going forward and prepare financial projections to support same;
- Negotiating with potential investors who could participate in the restructuring; and
- Determine the terms of a viable proposal to settle with its unsecured creditors.
- 10. The Debtor is filing a Motion to Extend the Delay for the Filing of a Proposal, in order to allow it to complete its dealings with regards to the above-mentioned key elements and to determine its financing requirements as well as to enable the formulation of a viable proposal to its creditors.
- 11. The Debtor's secured creditor, TD Bank, does not object to the requested extension and support the Debtor in its reorganization efforts.
- 12. The Debtor has prepared additional Cash Flow Projections for the period ending November 1, 2013. Annexed hereto as **Exhibit "E"** is the Statement of Projected Cash Flow covering the period from September 7, 2013 to November 1, 2013, the Trustee's Report on the reasonableness of the Projections in accordance with Section 50.4(2)(b) of the Act and the Debtor's Report pursuant to Section 50.4(2)(c) of the Act.
- 13. If the extension is granted, we are not aware of any facts indicating that any creditor would suffer a prejudice.
- 14. In the event that the extension is not granted and a Bankruptcy ensues, any reorganization efforts of the business would cease. Given the quantum of the secured debts, the orderly liquidation of the Company's assets would likely result in no dividend to the unsecured creditors. Consequently, the creditors' best opportunity to maximize recovery in this matter is to allow the Company time to continue its reorganization efforts and attempt to formulate a Proposal.
- 15. Given the foregoing, the Trustee hereby recommends the granting of the extension by the Court to October 31, 2013.

What we do know is that this restructuring will put Romatec into a much stronger and stable position going forward...a position that will enable it to meet its obligations in the future. We value our relationship with you and understand that the current situation strains that relationship but it is our desire to continue to work with you as we go through this process and even more importantly into the future as we come out from the restructuring over the next quarter or so. This current situation is difficult and obviously not something that any of us want but it is the reality and we respectfully request your continued support as we work through this together.

As mentioned our bank is working with us and we have the financial capabilities to service the market today and moving forward. I would like to discuss and establish a mutually agreeable framework on how our organizations can continue to work together going forward from today and would be pleased to the provide a framework to ensure there is assurances of no increased exposure.

Romatec is still, and will continue to be, very well positioned to service the customer and the market.
