MOTION FOR THE APPROVAL OF A PROPOSAL

(Sections 58 et seg. of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act)

TO ONE OF THE JUDGES OF THE SUPERIOR COURT SITTING IN THE COMMERCIAL DIVISION FOR THE DISTRICT OF MONTRÉAL, THE DEBTOR/PETITIONER STATES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By the present motion the Debtor/Petitioner, Romatec Inc. ("Romatec"), is seeking the approval of a proposal filed on January 9, 2014 (the "Proposal").
- Romatec is a corporation constituted under the Canada Business Corporations
 Act having its principal place of business in Montréal, Québec.
- Romatec has been in the business of distributing industrial valves, pumps and
 instrumentation products and solutions for the process industry for over 50 years.
 More precisely, Romatec actuates valves for clients in sectors such as Oil and
 Gas, Agricultural, Mining, Industrial and Water & Wastewater industries.
- 4. On August 16, 2013, due to general economic downturn and to increased competition, Romatec filed a Notice of Intention to File a Proposal with the Official Receiver, and Richter Advisory Group Inc. ("Richter") was appointed trustee thereunder, the whole as more fully appears from the Court's record.
- Romatec was initially required to file a proposal at the latest on September 15, 2013. Romatec however obtained three extensions of delay to file its proposal. The latest extension expired on January 30, 2014, the whole as more fully appears from the Court record.

- On January 9, 2014, Romatec filed the Proposal with Richter, the whole as more fully appears from a copy of the Proposal communicated herewith as Exhibit R-1 to form part hereof.
- 7. A meeting of the creditors was held on January 30, 2014 at the office of the Superintendent of bankruptcy, the whole as more fully appears from a copy of the Notice of Proposal to Creditors and Notice of Hearing of Application for Court Approval of Proposal (the "Notice") communicated herewith as Exhibit R-2 to form part hereof.
- 8. All capitalized terms herein that are not otherwise defined shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Proposal.
- The Proposal provides, among other things, for:
 - a) payment in full of the Employee Claims, Crown Claims and of the Preferred Claims
 - b) payment in full for each of the Ordinary Unsecured Creditors having a Proven Claim of less than \$500, without interest or penalty; and
 - c) payment for each of the Ordinary Unsecured Creditors having a Proven Claim of at least \$500, without interest or penalty, of its pro rata share of any amount remaining.

The whole as more fully appears from the Proposal.

- The Proposal is not addressed to the Secured Creditors.
- 11. At the meeting of the creditors, the creditors voted by a majority of 97.67% in number representing 96.20% of the value of the Ordinary Unsecured Claims to accept the Proposal, the whole as more fully appears from a copy of the minutes of such meeting communicated herewith as Exhibit R-3 to form part hereof.
- 12. Richter sent a notice of the hearing of this motion within the prescribed delay to Romatec, the Official Receiver and to every creditors who had a Proven Claim, the whole as more fully appears from a copy of the Notice.
- 13. On February 5, 2014, Richter completed its report on the Proposal (the "Report") and forwarded a copy of same to the Official Receiver, the whole as more fully appears from a copy of the Report communicated herewith as Exhibit R-4 to form part hereof.
- 14. In the Report, Richter states that the Proposal is an advantageous one for the creditors of Romatec. Richter is also of the view that in a bankruptcy scenario, there would be no dividend payable to the Ordinary Unsecured Creditors.

15. The terms of the Proposal are thus reasonable and will certainly benefit the general body of the creditors of Romatec.

WHEREFORE, MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT TO:

- [A] GRANT the present Motion for the Approval of a Proposal;
- [B] APPROVE the proposal of Debtor/Petitioner, Romatec Inc., filed on January 9, 2014;
- [C] THE WHOLE, without costs, save in the event of contestation.
