MOTION TO EXTEND THE STAY TERMINATION DATE

(Articles 9 and 11 of the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act)

TO ONE OF THE HONOURABLE JUDGES OF THE SUPERIOR COURT, SITTING IN COMMERCIAL DIVISION, IN AND FOR THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF MONTRÉAL, PETITIONER RESPECTFULLY SUBMITS THE FOLLOWING:

PETITIONER AND PROCEEDINGS

- 1. SR Telecom Inc. ("SRT" or "Petitioner") was incorporated under the *Canada Business Corporations Act* on February 17, 1981;
- 2. In 1986, SRT completed an initial public offering in Canada. Its common shares trade on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol "SRX". As at today's date, SRT has 754,992,769 common shares issued and outstanding;
- 3. SRT is a reporting issuer, or its equivalent, in all Canadian Provinces and the Northwest Territories and is a registrant with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC"). However, on November 6, 2007, SRT commenced the process to terminate the registration of its common shares with the SEC;
- 4. SRT's head office and principal place of business are located at 8150 Trans-Canada Highway, in the city of Saint Laurent;

- 5. On November 19, 2007, an initial Order ("Initial Order") was rendered by Honourable Justice Chantal Corriveau, J.C.S., pursuant to the *Companies Creditors Arrangement Act* in relation to SRT;
- 6. A detailed description of the circumstances of Petitioner and the reasons for requesting the Initial Order are set out in the Motion for an Initial Order pursuant to Sections 4, 5 and 11 of the Companies Creditors Arrangement Act dated November 18, 2007 (the "Initial Motion");
- 7. On December 10, 2007, an order (the "**December 10 Order**") was rendered by Honourable Justice Chantal Corriveau J.C.S. wherein the Court, *inter alia*:
 - (a) Approved a key employee retention program; and
 - (b) Authorized Petitioner to enter into an amended agreement with Lazard Frères & Co. LLC ("Lazard");
- 8. Any capitalized terms that are not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed in the Initial Order:

PURPOSE OF THIS MOTION

9. The purpose of this motion is to seek an extension of the Stay Termination Date (as defined in paragraph 7 of the Initial Order) to February 29, 2008;

THE MONITOR'S REPORT

- 10. Petitioner files herewith as Exhibit P-1 the first report of the designated Monitor on the state of Petitioner's financial affairs dated December 14, 2007 (the "Monitor's Report");
- 11. The Monitor's Report deals, *inter alia*, with the following:
 - (a) the ongoing sales process with Lazard (the "Sales Process");
 - (b) the pending sale transaction relating to Petitioner's SR500 Group of products (part of Petitioner's Current Products as defined in the Monitor's Report), including a proposed service agreement;
 - (c) ongoing operational and other restructuring measures, including in relation to Petitioner's: (i) customers and negotiation of accelerated payment terms, (ii) work force and (iii) contract manufacturers;
 - (d) Petitioner's financial position, including its balance sheet, cash balances, accounts receivable, accounts payable and other assets, its indebtedness and its liquidity position; and
 - (e) the activities of the Monitor;

CONCLUSIONS SOUGHT

- 12. As mentioned in the Initial Motion, the core of SRT restructuring plan is to capitalize on the upcoming opportunities that WiMAX presents through the sale of its assets or business on a going concern basis to a strategic purchaser, who will be able to provide continued employment for the employees and preserve customer and supplier relationships;
- 13. As appears from the Monitor's Report, Petitioner has acted and is continuing to act in good faith and with due diligence in relation to its financial and operational restructuring, as well as in relation to the Sales Process, the whole with a view to preserving the value of its business and assets, to realizing such value to the benefit of its stakeholders in the context of the sales process and to being able to present a plan of arrangement to its creditors;
- 14. Petitioner requests an extension of the Stay Termination Date to February 29, 2008 in order to have the necessary time to diligently continue the Sales Process, the whole under the continued and necessary protection afforded to it under the terms of the Initial Order;
- 15. It is also the Monitor's view that Petitioner:
 - (a) has and continues to act in good faith;
 - (b) needs additional time under court protection in order to complete the Sales Process and present a plan of arrangement to its creditors; and
 - (c) has not prejudiced its creditors and has paid for liabilities incurred since the rendering of the Initial Order;
- 16. Petitioner also submits that the extension requested is necessary in order to allow for its restructuring under the CCAA, and to protect and preserve the interests of its stakeholders, including its creditors, and that such extension will not prejudice any of the parties involved;
- 17. The present Motion is well founded in fact and in law;

WHEREFORE MAY IT PLEASE THIS HONOURABLE COURT TO:

GRANT this Motion:

DECLARE that the time for service of the present Motion is hereby abridged such that the Motion is properly presentable, and further the Petitioner is dispensed from any requirements for further service of the Motion;

ORDER that the order rendered Corriveau J. on November 19, 2007 (the "Initial Order") remain in full force and effect and that the Stay Termination Date (as defined in paragraph 7 of the Initial Order) be hereby extended to February 29, 2008;

DECLARE the orders to be rendered pursuant hereto executory notwithstanding any appeal therefrom or application seeking leave to appeal therefrom;

THE WHOLE WITHOUT COSTS, save and except in case of contestation.
